

## INSTRUCTIONS

One of the requirements for Confirmation is you must write (or type) a letter to Fr. Jim to explain to him why you want to be Confirmed. At Confirmation the Bishop will ask Fr. Jim if you have been prepared for the sacrament of Confirmation and your letter is how Fr. Jim can confidently say that you are ready to receive the sacrament. Below you will find the requirements for your letter to Fr. Jim.

- Letter must be written on a separate piece of paper. If letter is written on the back of the instructions, it will be returned to you.
- The letter should be approximately 1 page long and include the following:
  - Your name
  - Why you want to be Confirmed.
  - How receiving this sacrament will change or enhance your faith life.
  - Ways you plan to stay involved in the parish after Confirmation.
- Handwritten letters must be legible for Fr. Jim to read it. (Fr. Jim reads every letter.)
- Letters are due by your Retreat Day. They can be turned in early to your
  Catechist when completed.
