# **Meeting Minutes**

## December 16, 2025

1. The meeting began at 7:02 P.M. with a prayer by Matt Taggert.

2. It was moved by Maureen Szczypka and seconded by Tom Debolski to approve the November 18, 2025 Meeting Minutes.

# 3. Financial Statement Review – Fiscal YTD November 2025 Matt Taggart advised that the November 2025 financial statements were not available at this time. There was a problem obtaining the bank statement from the credit union in time to have the financial statements available for the meeting.

#### 4. 2026-2027 Tuition

Matt Taggert provided the finance council with a document containing suggested tuition increases and other fee increases for the school year beginning September 2026. After much discussion it was unanimously agreed that there would be a 5% increase in tuition, modified based on family size. In addition, a security fee of \$200 per student, capped at \$400 per family, was agreed to. Finally, a registration/technology fee of \$300 per student was agreed to.

# 4. General Discussion:

- a. Greg Laskowsky advised the finance council that new ceiling tiles have been installed at the front entrance of the gathering area.
- b. Maureen Szczypka advised the finance council that she will be contacting Kevin Prost to see if a meeting can be set up with the appropriate people at Gesu School to investigate the possibility of of setting up a data base of St. Edith School alumni.

# 5. Fr. Jim's Comments

- a. Father advised the finance council that a Safety Officer was hired and she will be starting in January 2026. Matt Taggert added that the cost of the Safety Officer is not in the current fiscal year budget; however, approximately \$10,000 has been received from generous parents of school children to help defray the added cost to the school.
- b. Father advised the finance council that a second quote was received to convert the restroom doors in the church to handicapped doors. The vendor is JMHR Group and the cost is \$7,000. The finance council members agreed with the expenditure.
- c. Father advised that the speakers in the church have been adjusted and the sound is much better.

The meeting ended at 7:40 p.m. with prayer.

7. Tom O'Meara volunteered to say the opening prayer at the next meeting.
