Meeting Minutes

March 17, 2026

Attendees: Fr. Jim McNulty, Matt Taggart, Tom Debolski, Kevin Prost, Tom O'Meara

Absent: Maureen Szczypka, Greg Laskowsky, John Brady

1. The meeting began at 7:02 P.M. with a prayer by Matt Taggart.
2. It was moved by Tom Debolski and seconded by Kevin Prost to approve the February 17, 2026 Meeting Minutes.
3. Financial Statement Review – Fiscal YTD February 2026.
 - a. Matt Taggart reviewed and explained all the significant variances for the school and the church.
 - b. The school profit is \$59,088 which is net of \$59,803 of capital expenditures.
 - c. The church profit is \$180,111 which is net of \$100,848 of capital expenditures.
4. General Discussion:
 - a. Matt Taggart stated that the final numbers for the “Meet Your Match” campaign are as follows: (19) New online givers for a total of \$2,607 and (57) increases by online givers in the amount of \$3,129 for a total of (76) participants and a total of \$5,736.
 - b. Greg Laskowsky provided the finance council with an email listing several maintenance items for our review i.e. some cement areas need attention, parking lot chuck holes need patching and some floor tiles need replacement in the school.
 - c. Tom Debolski mentioned the flooding of the parking lot outside the entrance to the church that occurred the weekend of March 6, 2026. Fr. Jim advised that water was due to a plugged drain.
5. Fr. Jim's Comments:
 - a. Fr. Jim advised the finance council that parishioners will be invited to discuss and give input regarding the Archdiocesan Restructuring Plan on June 8, 2026, and June 10, 2026. Details will follow in the parish bulletin.
 - b. Fr Jim also suggested that we all should be positive in our discussions about the restructuring process because it will be very positive for the archdiocese.
6. Closing Prayer
The meeting ended at 7:40 p.m. with prayer.
