



Life Remodeled Neighborhood Work Day

Annually, Life Remodeled hosts the “6 Day Event” which is a community-led, intentional, and equitable revitalization of Detroit neighborhoods. Volunteers mow, trim, and weed vacant properties and the yards of Seniors, veterans, and people with disabilities.

VOLUNTEERS:

Volunteers must be 14 years old and up. Minors must attend with a parent/guardian or parent/guardian must arrange with another family to have an adult supervising and transporting their child. Transportation will not be provided. **All** volunteers must sign a digital waiver from Life Remodeled which will be emailed to you after you register on Sign Up Genius. **Registration for this event will close on August 30, 2022.**

Volunteers who need service hours for Confirmation preparation, school, National Honor Society, etc., please let Patti know and she will sign off for them.

ARRIVAL TIME:

Please arrive **at St. Edith** (front parking lot near Office) at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, October 8, 2022. We will leave by 11:05 a.m. and caravan to the former Cooley High School (15055 Hubbell Ave, Detroit, MI 48227) arriving prior to 11:45 a.m.

HOW IT WORKS:

When we arrive at the site, we will board a shuttle bus that will transport us to a Command Center in the neighborhood. There, we will receive our assignment as well as all the tools and supplies needed and then walk to our service location. Blight removal and beautification will be from 12-4:00 p.m.

At the end of the shift, volunteers will return their equipment to the Command Center and be bussed back to the parking lot to return to their vehicles.

DRESS CODE & WHAT TO BRING:

Volunteers will be provided a t-shirt and are required to wear the t-shirt at the event. If you have protective eyewear/sunglasses and work gloves, please bring them. If you don't have them, we will have some for you. Water and snacks will be provided. As we will be working outside, closed-toe shoes are required.
