1. The meeting began at 7:00 P.M. with prayer led by Tom O'Meara.
2. It was moved by Judy O'Meara and seconded by Greg Laskowsky to approve the October 25, 2021 Meeting Minutes.
3. Report from Parish Council.
 - a. The Council is considering how to tabulate the results of the parish survey in a timely manner.
 - b. Josh Kugler is resigning as Youth and Young Adult Minister. Upon his resignation a volunteer with the Youth Group and Deacon Don will assume Josh's duties going forward.

Tom O'Meara reported that the school profit is \$69,735 (net of favorable timing differences of \$105,940). The church loss is \$32,588 (net of unfavorable timing differences of \$28,714).
5. Capital Projects.

Fr. Jim reported that the sound system in the church has been updated with wireless microphones at a cost of \$3,801. The mixer was also replaced at a cost of \$2,399. In Praise covered the cost of the mixer. The work was done by AFP Sound System.
6. Cares Act.

Tom O'Meara stated that passing the basket at Masses has proven to be beneficial.
