# **Religious Formation News:**

- Re classes resumed on Sept. 15th and 16th. At this time, we have 226 non-SES students enrolled on Sundays and Mondays.
- We have 4 new catechists helping this year and 4 new additional subs.
- Confirmation Prep and Reconciliation/Eucharist parent meetings were held during the first 2 class meetings on Sunday and Monday.
