CAPTIONING

- 1 I BELIEVE**  
Born from fourth-century debate, the Nicene Creed remains the foundation of Christian belief. In an age of doubt and disaffiliation, it invites us to ask: What does it mean to believe in God?
- 2 GOD, THE FATHER ALMIGHTY**  
“What is God?” The Creed offers a timeless answer: the one unconditioned Creator, Father of all that is.
- 3 JESUS CHRIST, THE ONLY BEGOTTEN SON**  
“I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ.” At the heart of Christian faith stands a person—Jesus of Nazareth, true God from true God.
- 4 HE SUFFERED DEATH**  
At the heart of the Creed is the Paschal Mystery: Christ crucified, risen, and reigning.
- 5 HOLY SPIRIT, THE GIVER OF LIFE**  
The Creed proclaims the Holy Spirit—the living “holy breath,” giver of life, poured out on God’s people.
- 6 ONE, HOLY, CATHOLIC, AND APOSTOLIC**  
The Creed proclaims the Church—one, holy, catholic, and apostolic—Christ’s living sacrament in the world.
